Each pre-college piano or piano concerto participant in GMTA's local, regional, and state auditions is required to take and pass one of the four (4) theory exams ("GATEs") in order to advance beyond local auditions. Students may become EXEMPT from taking some or all of the GATEs. We are very pleased to have so many teachers and students involved in Music Day again this year.

Student schedules will be going out in a different email. We have made every effort to honor scheduling requests. If your student cannot attend at their scheduled time, they may switch to Virtual. Contact Kathy Dawal to arrange.

Teacher numbers must be marked on the back of every rating sheet.

This will allow us to put them in the correct teacher file. All instructions and information about teacher numbers, virtual event etc. will be provided soon.

Student schedules will go out in a separate email.

This year the provision has been added to allow teachers to exempt out of work on the actual day by paying a fee or sending an adult substitute.

We hope that will make participation easier for teachers who need to be elsewhere on November 15.

Please keep in mind the following information from our website:

The GCMTA sponsors a Music Day festival every November. The purpose of this festival is to encourage study and to provide an opportunity for students to perform and receive an evaluation of their performance and cash awards. Proceeds from Music Day are used to provide funds for scholarships and to support the budget.

Registration Deadline: Submitted online by Friday, October 17,

Entry Fee: \$25.00 per student, plus \$10 each additional instrument.

Teacher Requirements:

- 1. Teachers entering students in Music Day must have all dues confirmed as paid.
- 2. All teachers entering students in Music Day are required to work the event on the following basis:
 - a.7 or fewer students: work ½ day, assist with setting up or clean up.
 - b.8-14 students: work a full day, assist with clean up.
 - c.15 or more students: work a full day and assist in an administrative role.
- 3. Teacher work requirements are mandatory regardless of student cancellations; however, a teacher may pay an exemption fee of \$50 for ½ day, \$100 for a full day, or a teacher may send an approved adult substitute.
